I. **Call meeting to order @ 6:20 p.m.**

II. **Approval of agenda:**

IV. **Old Business:**

a. Strategic Plan-Book Study/Intervention Monitoring:

According to our Strategic Plan, we are supposed to have a weekly book study and do Intervention monitoring. We are currently on our third book for Personalized Learning "Go Blended". And we have weekly or bi-weekly progress monitoring, depending on our students' tier.

b. Title 1 Meeting Update (Literacy evening activity: Books for Bingo) and library furniture/Book purchases for main and classroom libraries/Power Point re Title 1):

We have been having Title 1 parent/community events and they have been very enjoyed and well attended. Our libraries (classroom and main) have received approximately \$3000 of books and more on the way. We have sponsored Love A Book and Dr. Seuss Day, where books were given to students to take home. We have Books for Bingo coming up in April when students will win more books. And we have library furniture arriving in early June.

c. Tebughna Challenge update: Christy and Jim will be deciding on April 6th who qualifies for our trip on April 12th-13th, depending on meeting the challenge criteria.

d. Personalized Learning/Educational Elements-Fall: We were supposed to begin in late Spring but now will begin in Fall 2018.

e. Upcoming activities (Bingo For Books, Winter Bear, Identity Week, Prom, Game Night, Beluga Watch):

Books for Bingo in April, Identity Week April 16th begins, Winter Bear April 12th-13th (Teaching students to act on April 12th, potluck on the 13th at 5:30 pm and performance at 6 p.m.), Prom May 18th, Game Night, May 11th, and Beluga Watch September 15th.

f. Testing: AIMS/Ed Performance; MAPs Pilot, PEAKS:

We will be a pilot school for MAPS universal testing this upcoming year. And PEAKS is March 29th-April 13th. Ed Performance and AIMS web is in May.

g. PBIS: Check in, Check out: Six students are using this PBIS tool to have a positive consequence for their behavior. There are incentives for meeting the goals set by the students.

h. Budget update/Certified Staffing: We looked over the budget information and Teacher/Student ratios shared by the district.

V. New Business:

- a. Youth Strategic Plan: Tebughna Foundation has invited us to participate in a 3-year plan, where students work with the community to be successful in life. The Tebughna Foundation received a grant from ANA (Administration for Native Americans), based on the wisdom that our youth are our future leaders. We will be participating in the planning (meeting April 3-5) and are looking forward to Elders “adopting” students for their benefit.
- c. Fire alarm system: The Borough has completely installed a fire alarm system with warning lights and loud alarms throughout the school.
- d. ALICE drill: We worked with the Tribal Center, Nikiski Fire Department, Alaska Troopers, and the School District in planning and carrying out a “real” ALICE drill. It was very successful, in large part due to the Tribal Center, Art Standifer, Nikiski Fire Department and Tim Chuitt.
- e. Full time SPED/Interventionist opening: Mr. Vlasak is setting up interviews with applicants to fill this position for next year.
- e. Student Count as of March 20, 2018 is: 31
- f. New Principal: Michael Allen-comes May 14. Pam will arrange meetings so he can meet the community and our many partnerships.
