III. New Business

- a. **Site Goals:** Continue to have 2 teachers, 3 parents, 1 community member, and 1 student on council. Jim will work on getting a student. Locate binder of by laws. Meet at least 4 times during school year.
- b. **New Schedule:** Directed by district office to go to two-classroom system with team teaching: K-6 – Mrs. Gomez and Ms. Acosta; 7-12 – Mr. Breske, Mr. Perzechino, Ms. Mann. Twenty-minute blocks to present materials through rotations. GradPoint introduced last week, students have accepted using this. Credit recovery through this also. Parents/students do not like all grades in the same room, however more supervision is appreciated. Parents welcome to come and observe how the schedule is working out. Council wants schedule on next meeting's agenda to evaluate how it's progressing.
- c. **Attendance:** 79.67% first five week of school, climb in attendance last few weeks. Target attendance for Tebughna Foundation is 80%. With Moose Camp/State Fair over may see increase in attendance. Would like to make a goal of 90% attendance. Tebughna Foundation would like to have rewards for attendance. Need to meet with teachers regarding award ceremonies for student of the month, academics, etc.
- d. **Performance Series:** Twenty-minute core classes tied into Performance Series results; helps students who are behind and enriches those students who are doing well. Data will identify strengths/weaknesses.

- e. **Tebughna Foundation:** Developing a rewards/prize program for attendance, academics, and behavior. Decision to be determined regarding how to do awards/prizes: class reward, school-wide reward or K-6, 7-12 rewards. Possible awards: pizza party, ice cream party, movie/popcorn party, and gas cards. Question of how to include students with a “don’t care” attitude?” Need to have an open discussion, such as a talking circle; regarding issues students may be having regarding why they don’t want to attend school, etc. Resource for talking circle could be Nick Gonzales.
- f. **Tebughna Challenge Trip:** October-May, tie into attendance at certain percentage, not a lot of tardies, and behavior. Money is a question – have writing classes to ask for donations from companies. Need mentors to help struggling students so they will have an opportunity to attend.
- g. **Community/Cultural Awareness:** Need to have cultural awareness classes once a week to get community together. Open shop once a week, possible teacher or parent volunteers, for a couple hours to work on bikes, build/auction dog sleds, carving soapstone, beading, etc. Moose tanning participation 10 hours/day for two weeks starts in January. Suicide Prevention Class can be set up with Marian King, health class to teach CPR/first aide for rural areas can be set up with clinic. Post clinic phone numbers in classrooms and hallways (clinic: 583-2461, cell: 317-8322)
- h. **Fire Prevention/Fire Department:** Activities for month of October (weather permitting) on Mondays or Wednesdays with fire department. Fire department will bring truck to school. Approximately one-hour activities.
