Dear Parents,

Also, summer can be a wonderful opportunity for math practice!

- **Number Sense:** Count objects regularly such as cans, people, dogs, birds...
- **Skip Counting:** 2, 4, 6, and 8. This helps to count faster and with confidence.
- **One to one Relationship:** Ask him to get 10 spoons, 5 forks and 3 plates. Use them to add, subtract, divide them into groups (like 3 groups of six items). Or have him count to 50 while bouncing a ball. Every fifth bounce, he/she can swing their leg over the ball to get the "counting by fives" rhythm.

Thank you for the support you have given the teachers and myself this year. It has been an honor and a privilege to be in Tyonek. I will miss each of you! And Happy Trails!
